## AGREEMENT TERMINATING SHORT-TERM LAND USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH & HUMAN SERVICES AND COLLEGE OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS

This Agreement Terminating Short-Term Land Use Agreement Between Department of Health & Human Services and College of the Marshall Islands ("Termination Agreement") is made in November 2022 by the Department of Health & Human Services ("DOHHS") and the College of the Marshall Islands ("CMI") with the approval of the National Disaster Committee.

WHEREAS, the October-November 2021 Short-Term Land Use Agreement Between Department of Health & Human Services and College of the Marshall Islands ("Short-Term Land Use Agreement") was entered to provide an area from which DOHHS could provide a building and quarantine services related to the Covid-19 pandemic on a short-term basis;

WHEREAS, DOHHS no longer requires use of the area; and

WHEREAS, no payments have been made by DOHHS to CMI,

**WITNESSETH**, that DOHHS and CMI agree that the Short-Term Land Use Agreement is terminated as of midnight December 31, 2022, and DOHHS shall not have any ownership rights to or possession of any buildings and improvements remaining on the premises after the date of termination.
