## LETTER OF INTENT ON NURSING COOPERATION BETWEEN TAIPEI MEDICAL UNIVERSITY OF THE REPUBLIC OF CHINA (TAIWAN) AND COLLEGE OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE MARSHALL ISLANDS

This Letter of Intent (LOI) is made on this \_\_\_\_\_ of December 2017, by and between the Taipei Medical University (TMU) and the College of the Marshall Islands (CMI) (hereafter collectively "the Parties") concerning the further cooperation between the Parties.

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to promote cooperation in the field of nursing;

WHEREAS, the Parties recognize the importance of the nursing development in enhancing the standards and services quality of the Republic of the Marshall Islands;

WHEREAS, Taipei Medical University wishes to share Taiwan nursing development experience and the College of the Marshall Islands considers such assistance of great value to its developmental efforts;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of these recitals and premises, the Parties hereto agree to respectively sign an agreement for further collaboration.

This LOI expresses the intentions of the parties and places no financial obligations or supplementary funding commitments on either party. The terms of cooperation for each activity under this LOI shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon by both parties prior to initiation of that activity.

This LOI shall be in effect for a period of 2 (two) years, and shall automatically be renewed for a similar period unless a Party notifies the other, in writing, of its intention to terminate this LOI at least 3 (three) months prior to its intended date of termination. The termination of this LOI shall not prejudice the arrangements, programs, activities and/or projects initiated or made within this LOI.

This Letter of Intent is completed in English and is hereby signed on 2 (two) copies, with 1 (one) copy remaining in the possession of each party.
