- 2. CAP 066 / CMI 101 Update Representatives of CMI, DevEd, and STEM departments, as well as Administration (Andrea, Jennifer, Ernest, Curtis, Hermon, Ruth) reviewed the CAC recommendations made December 1, 2014 and shared the following points. No action was taken.

- a. A new credit-level course should be created to fill the technology gap between CAP 066 and ICS 101. It should focus on e-portfolios. The pre-requisite will be CAP 066 or placement. Not sure if it should satisfy the technology requirement for General Education or just be a pre-requisite for ICS 101.
- b. Since it will be a pre-requisite to the new course, students who do not pass CAP 066 will have to retake it.
- c. All new students should take a CAP placement exam to determine placement in either CAP 066 or the new course.
- d. The pre-requisite for ICS 101 should be changed to that of the new technology course. The English 80s pre-requisite should be dropped and the course revised to be less textbook heavy.
- e. CMI 101 course should not be changed to include 1 credit technology component to help prepare students for ICS101
- 3. Education Program Review, Section I Not reviewed. Section 1 is still missing the Budget section.
