The meeting was called to order at 11:05A.M. in BOR Conference Room by Mary Van Auken, chair.

- 1. December 04th & 11th, 2017 Draft Minutes Moved to approve w/ minor edits. Seconded. Passed.
- 2. NURS 110 "Fundamentals of Nursing" course outline Moved to approve. Seconded. Passed
 - a) Cheryl confirmed that SIS is able to enter "co-requisites" as requested in NURS110 course outline. DOAA also note course contents fit well to take as co-requisites.
- 3. Education PLOs
 - a) Education Department has three different sets of PLOS for its three programs. Department chair will review and bring back updates in January 2018.

4. Math PLOs to STEM

- a) Developmental Education (Dev Ed) is ok regarding movement of Math PLOs to STEM. However, prefers to remain as Dev Ed since CMI101 is not an English course.
- b) Dr. Nish raises question of does CMI101 belong to Dev Ed as it is a credit level course and also includes that we call CMI101 a program, but it's a class. It is not a First Year Experience (FYE) course either and not entirely a General Education course, but it hanged under LA Department and now Dev Ed.
- c) A CMI101 taskforce (Va, Mary, Jen, Elizabeth, Dr. Nish) will look into these matters and report back when CC reconvene next year.

5. ABE and Vocational

a) ABE Director has started working with departments to look into aligning and integrating its courses to Dev Ed and to Credit level courses. In addition, its fifth-level program needs to look into advanced curriculum and drilling for exam.

- b) As there is no curriculum at the ABE and Vocational Programs, instructors teach from textbooks. Department has never developed any curriculum and will need trainings, workshops and lots of support to be able to successfully integrate and align course outlines to Dev Ed and Credit level courses.
- c) Education Department can help with workshops as if students pass HISETS, they can enter into credit level.
