#### **Agenda Item(s):**

The meeting was called to order at 11:06A.M. in BOR Conference Room by Mary Van Auken, chair.

- 1. October 16, 2017 Draft Minutes Moved to approve w/ minor changes. Seconded. Passed.
  - a) Member name spelling
- 2. CC Procedure Group Report
  - a) Waiting for VP Mr. Kotton on budget template for new programs to finalize this.
- 3. Updated CC RSA Has been approved by EC according to an EC member in CC.
- 4. CAP066 Group Report
  - a) Keep the course, but need to make revisions to course outline and possibly integrated some course content in CMI101 and ICS101 courses.
  - b) "Typing" content in CAP066 is essential and students need more typing lessons. Committee is requesting for a typing software to be installed in all computer labs to help with this.
- 5. Social Issues vs Social Sciences Moved to approve. Seconded. Passed.
  - a) It was requested that General Education "Social Issues" course category be changed to "Social Sciences" to be in line with what other colleges are doing.
  - b) This means all programs will need to update their program sheets to reflect this change.
- 6. ENG 211 Will update and re-sent course outline for CC to review and comment for next meeting.
- 7. Marine Science Certificate Program sheet Moved to approve. Seconded. Passed.
  - a) Changed "Elective course" total credits from 4 credits to 3-4 credits which changed total program sheet credits from 31 to 30 credits total.
- 8. MSC 281-285 Moved to approve. Seconded. Passed.

- a) Changed course outline "Alpha Number" from "SCI 281-285" to "MSC 281-285". Also changed course titles to include total credits after each course title for SIS to accept.
- 9. Discussion of science courses without labs
  - a) Climate Change Certificate may be offered soon and department is looking at increasing science course offerings that don't have labs. For example, the Environmental Science Course here includes a lab, but in reality does not need the lab component. No colleges does this for their Environmental Science Courses.
- 10. Other discussions
  - a) Action Items from IEC:
    - All departments need a mission statement. Mission statements must be sent to IEC for review and approval.
    - CC needs to look at Developmental Education Department PLOs. Plan is to change department name from Dev Ed to Dev ENG. Math component will be moved to STeM Department.
    - CC needs to look at Education Department PLOs.
    - Business Studies Department has 2 mission statements. Must choose 1 and have CC review and approve.
