The Institutional Effectiveness Committee's *first* meeting for January 2022, was called to order by the Chairperson at approximately 11:10 a.m.

1. Mission Statement

a. The meeting started off with the mission statement being recited by the Dean of Academic Affairs.

2. Approval of Previous Meeting MINUTES

- **a.** The draft Minutes from December 8, 2022, were reviewed by the Committee.
 - i. After the committee reviewed the **MINUTES**, the VPASA made a motion to approve the **MINUTES**. The Faculty Senate Representative seconded the motion, as the motion was carried successfully with one abstention.

DECISION



With no corrections, the IEC meeting MINUTES for December 8, 2022, were approved.

3. <u>Action Items</u>

a. As per the Chairperson, there were no action items for the Committee's review.

4. Subcommittee and Working Group Updates:

a. Data Governance

i. Data Definition: Post Secondary - Student

- 1. The Director of IRA presented the data definition document for the Committee's final review.
- With no objections towards the document, the Director of IRA made a motion to approve the *Data Dictionary: Post Secondary - Student*. The Faculty Senate Representative seconded the motion, as the motion was successfully passed by the majority with no abstentions.

DECISION

Having no modifications, the *Data Dictionary: Post Secondary - Student* was approved as present.

5. <u>FACETS Update</u> - Director of IRA

a. Update from the PR Working Group

- i. The Program Review Working Group for Group 3-6, met on December 10, 2021 and January 11, 2022, to finalize the results of the Program Reviews.
- ii. The working group reviewed 27 Program Reviews.
 - 1. There was 1 Program Review that was submitted, however, did not have the supervisor's approval.
 - a. The working group went forward in reviewing the Program Review, after receiving confirmation from the supervisor.
 - 2. After the initial evaluations, there were 12 Program Reviews that were accepted, and 15 Program Reviews that "needed improvement."
 - 3. Some of the Working Group's findings included:
 - a. Missing Elements
 - b. Some units did not do data disaggregation



- c. Due to the reason that Cycle 2 has already started, returning the Program Reviews to the department heads was nonessential.
 - i. As a result, 9 of the 15 Program Reviews that "needed improvement," were accepted.
- 4. After the Program Review Working Group's meeting on January 11, 2022, there were 22 Program Reviews that were "accepted" and 6 that "needed improvement."
- 5. The 6 units that "needed improvement" were:
 - a. Accounting
 - b. Budget
 - c. Youth Corps
 - d. NSSP
 - e. Commercial Services
 - f. DE Center Jaluit
 - i. The IEC tasked the Working Group to work with the NSSP for clarification purposes on some of the instructions/results from the evaluation process.
 - The incomplete Program Reviews still needed to be completed and reviewed by the working group and submitted before the next IEC meeting on January 26, 2022.
 - The Chairperson informed the IEC members that the Prioritization of the Initiatives List from the Program Reviews is needed to move forward and should be submitted to the Budget Committee as soon as possible.

6. <u>Integrated Planning Cycle: Prioritization - EVP</u>

a. Compilation of the Programmatic Initiatives from the Approved PRs

- i. The Chairperson deferred this for the next IEC meeting on January 26, 2022.
- ii. Updating of Strategic Plan Asana Project
 - 1. The Chairperson/EVP shared and explained the project with the Committee members.
 - 2. Due to the delay of the approved PRs, the project will be reviewed by the Committee in their next meeting.

 - i. The incomplete SLO Assessments from Group 2 are due for IEC's review on January 26, 2022.

8. <u>ISLO Assessment Update - VPASA</u>

- **a.** The VPASA shared with IEC members the document on the PLO Assessment: Assessment Unit Four Column Cycle 1 ISLO 1.
- **b.** ISO 1 "The CMI graduate will have life-goals and will know how to use available resources to achieve those goals." (Approved by IEC on July 28, 2021)
 - i. The Committee reviewed and discussed CMI and it's graduates' status in regards to ISLO 1.
- **c.** The Chairperson suggested to the Committee members of linking the document with the CMI Alumni Survey.
- **d.** The Committee members shared that each department should have critical thinking embedded in its programs.
 - i. The Dean of Academic Affairs was tasked to work on this recommendation and will report back to the IEC.
- **e.** The ISLO Assessment Update will also be recommended for the Learning Support Committee in regards to a possible co-curricular approach.

9. Accreditation Update



- **a.** Standard IA4: The institution articulates its mission in a widely published statement approved by the governing board. The mission statement is periodically reviewed and updated as necessary.
 - i. Due to the interest of time, this was deferred.
