a. The meeting started off with the mission statement being recited by the Chairperson/EVP.

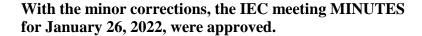
2. Approval of Previous Meeting MINUTES

 - b. The VPASA shared the Associate Deans availability to assist the department Chairpersons, including with the Program Reviews.

a. Data Governance
